



East Park Academy Sports Premium Spending 2019-2020

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. Each year the school receive a lump sum per eligible pupil which is £21,390 for East Park Academy for 2019-2020.

At our school the money is being used in the following ways:

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons and to raise fitness levels.
- 2) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils and to give our children a sense of belonging to the house teams establishes across school.
- 3) To increase engagement in sports and inspire our children to participate fully in PE lessons and the wider community competitions.
- 4) To teach and develop the skill of swimming according to the National Curriculum guidelines.

The cost will be as follows:

Action	Cost	Impact
Swimming across Year 3 in the first instance, once a week for 10 weeks.	£3500	The children will be more confident swimmers, improve stroke quality and be able to swim 25m according to the National Curriculum guidelines.
Catch-up swimming lessons for those children in Year 6 who were not confident at the end of Year 3.	£3100	The children will leave Primary school being be more confident swimmers, improve stroke quality and be able to swim 25m. Children will also feel more confident in life-saving skills when faced in a dangerous situation.

Trophies and Equipment, including new kit for the football team.	£1595	That the children will feel part of a team all wearing matching and appropriate kit.
Training on the teaching of Gymnastics for all staff.	£3200	Increased participation of all KS 1 and 2 pupils in Gymnastics learning opportunities. This will also improve staff subject knowledge in delivering Gymnastics lessons to engage, challenge and motive pupils.
Sports week including visits and visitors to school. (athletes, footballers, dancers, choreographers and visits to stadiums and studios)	£8500	Increased participation in all PE opportunities. The children will have a thirst for these professions and have high aspirations.
Multi-sports club for Year 1, 2 and 3 children.	£1500	Increased participation in all PE opportunities. Improved confidence across in physical activity.
